

Kohala Coast, Hawaii 2022 Feast Activities

We are pleased to offer several planned activities for families and individuals at the Feast in Hawaii this year! The schedule of activities is listed below. Of course, you may sign up for one or more of these activities. Some are free of charge, and others require prepayment. We need to know how many plan to attend each of our events, so we may prepare for activities. Numbers of attendees are limited for some of the paid events, so please order your tickets early. *The deadline for ordering tickets is Sept. 12!*

This year we have a new online ticket ordering and payment process that will be easier than in past years. The links for these online forms can be found next to each activity below.

We are also planning to provide a Hawaiian name tag for each person attending the Feast in Hawaii this year. Make sure you stop by the Information Table and pick up your name tag and activity tickets.

Discounts: At the Fairmont Orchid Hotel, each child (aged 6-12) receives 50% off menu pricing when dining with parents at restaurants in the hotel during your stay (excludes In Room Dining, Brown's Deli and Beach and Pool Grill). Children aged 5 and under eat free (children's menu) with paying parents.

Parking and Use of Hotel Amenities: Please note that self-parking is free for Fairmont Orchid Hotel guests throughout your stay at the hotel. Hotel amenities (like snorkeling equipment, paddleboards, beach/pool towels and use of the swimming pools) are only for hotel guests. If you stay off-property, you may self-park free of charge while attending church services and planned activities. Overnight parking at the hotel is only allowed for registered hotel guests.

Activity Descriptions

Sunset Dinner Buffet and Welcome Reception: Sunday, Oct. 9, 5:30-7:30 p.m.

All attendees are invited to a get-acquainted sunset buffet dinner to meet and greet old and new friends in the Coconut Grove on the bay at the Fairmont Orchid Hotel. A Hawaiian sunset buffet dinner will be served, and a cash bar will be available for those reserving a spot and ordering a ticket. Catered Holy Day Buffet Luncheons: Monday, Oct. 10, and Monday, Oct. 17, 12-2 p.m.

Private catered luncheons will be offered for our group between services on both holy days. This will give everyone additional time for fellowship without waiting for a table and service in a restaurant or getting everyone into a vehicle to travel off-property for lunch. The Fairmont Orchid Hotel chef has put together a buffet luncheon menu that includes salads, two main entrees, dessert and beverages in a private setting for our group. Young Adult Voyager Canoe Trip and Continental Breakfast: Tuesday, Oct. 11, 6:30-9:45 a.m.

Young adults are invited to a private, early morning (you will be up early anyway with jet lag) guided voyager canoe trip from the bay and along the coast of the Fairmont Orchid Hotel. Canoeing is always better in the early morning hours, and this professionally guided tour includes learning about the early history of the Hawaiian Islands and paddling a voyager canoe in the Pacific surf.

Following the 30-minute canoe trip, you may go to the Paniolo Lounge for a continental breakfast and fellowship. Trips leave every 30 minutes beginning at 6:30 a.m. Prepaid price includes guide tip, tax and gratuity. Sign up early to guarantee your reservation. Family Sail and Snorkel on the 50-foot *Fairwinds II* Yacht: Thursday, Oct. 13, 2-5:30 p.m.

Climb aboard the Fair Wind II for a scenic [morning](#) or [afternoon](#) cruise along the shores south of Kona to historic Kealahou Bay. Jump into the pristine tropical waters of Kealahou Bay, considered the best snorkeling site in all of Hawaii, and enjoy our onboard high jump and waterslide! An ideal adventure for the whole family and all levels of snorkelers.

Enjoy a 3.5-hour trip aboard the private chartered *Fairwinds II* Yacht (1:30 p.m. check-in required) with 2-hours of snorkel time. All snorkel equipment is provided.
