Instructions for Puzzles

Word Search

Using the list of words below the letter grid, find and circle the words hidden in the letter grid. Words are hidden forward, backward, up-and-down and diagonally. Different words may overlap or cross each other.

Crossword

Place the answer to each clue in the corresponding numbered grid going across or down.

Double Puzzles

Unscramble each of the clue words. Copy the letters in the numbered cells to other cells with the same number to solve the mystery phrase or word.

Fallen Puzzle

A fallen phrase puzzle is a puzzle where all the letters have fallen to the bottom. However, they got mixed up on their way down, but remain in the same column.

Your goal is to reconstruct the phrase from the jumble of letters under the grid. The letters appearing in each column of the completed phrase are scrambled directly under that column.

Helpful Tips:

1. Fill in any blank spaces with just letter underneath.
2. Try to figure out any 2-letter words.
3. Use trial and error to keep filling in the blanks until you solve the puzzle.

Letter Tiles

Unscramble the tiles to reveal a message. Each tile contains three characters—letters and spaces. Be sure to use each tile only once.

Cryptogram

Cryptogram puzzles contain a phrase or sentence that is encrypted with a number solution. Each cryptogram puzzle is related to a particular holiday. Remember, each puzzle uses different number solutions.
