

2018 Barbados Feast Update

Hello all,

After returning from Barbados earlier this week, I am updating you about this year's Feast.

Again, I need to know who will be arriving before the Sabbath of Sept. 22 so that we can accommodate you for services. Only one family informed me that they are arriving before the Sabbath. Based on check-in information at Accra, several others will be coming earlier. So again, I need to know who is coming early. We do not have use of the auditorium at Accra until Sunday, Sept. 23. Alternative arrangements have to be made for the Sabbath before. Send me an email (arnold.hampton@cogwa.org) by next week if you are arriving early and how many of you will be attending services on the Sept. 22 so that arrangements can be made. Those of you with your own transportation can email me about the location and time.

The catamaran cruise has been moved to Tuesday, Sept. 25. It will last from 2:30 to 7 p.m. There will be two snorkeling dives with the turtles. A lunch will be served. Since the sun sets just after 6 p.m., we should be able to view the sunset as we return to harbor. The cost is US\$60 for adults and US\$40 for children 12 and under. If interested, let me know. Thanks to those who have already responded. If the details above cause a change of mind, let me know.

The hotel provides a Barbecue Dinner with Floor Show on Thursdays. This is an opportunity to sample Barbadian cuisine served buffet style. The price for guests is approximately US\$43 for adults and US\$22 for children under 12. I was told that a discount is possible if we have a group attending. Let me know if you would be interested with the number of adults and children.

Finally, the hotel will provide lunch between services on the Last Great Day. The cost is US\$35 for adults and US\$20 for children under 12. I have to give the hotel an estimate of adults and children who will be participating.
