Stonehenge Tour: Tuesday, Sept. 29, 1-5:30 p.m.

Stonehenge is one of the most famous prehistoric monuments in the world. Archaeologists believe it was built in several stages between about 3000 B.C. and 2000 B.C.

Tour includes: Transport from the Royal Bath Hotel, a professional Blue Badge guided walk around the Stone Circle and among the Neolithic houses, and the Exhibition, which contains nearly 300 archaeological objects and finds from Stonehenge and other nearby monuments.

Cost (includes transport, guide, general admissions ticket and fees):
