

Branson, Missouri 2017 Feast Activities

Branson will once again host a variety of planned activities for all ages. In addition to planned activities, the area has a host of entertainment venues for all ages, ranging from over 60 live shows, museums, golf courses, mini-golf, go-karts and other venues. We have arranged discount prices for members at many of the theaters and museums, as well as certain attractions. These will be available on request after the first of August. You can request them either via email or via U.S. mail.

We have a number of planned Feast activities, but **there are no activities in Branson requiring advance payment before the Feast!**

Family Dance: We will host a family dance on Sunday evening, Oct. 8, at the West Wing of the White House Theatre. It will run from 7 to 10:30 p.m. and will feature music for all ages. Light snacks will be available. Dress for the dance is “nice casual.”

Senior Citizens’ Lunch: Our annual senior citizens’ lunch will be held on Monday, Oct. 9, and will feature a delicious barbecue meal featuring smoked beef brisket and smoked turkey. (Gluten free meals available on request.) We will have some good music and entertainment as well as plenty of time for visiting.

Teen Activity: Our teen activity this year will be held on Friday, Oct. 6, in order for teens to make new friends early in the Feast. It will be an afternoon of games, hot dog cookout and fellowship at Table Rock State Park. It will run from 1 to 4 p.m.

Festival Youth Instruction: We will once again have Festival Youth Instruction on Sunday and Tuesday mornings (Oct. 8 and 10) before services in the West Wing conference center at the White House Theatre. The general topic will be walking by faith. This is for all children from kindergarten through fifth or sixth grades.

Preteen Family Activity: Our preteen family activity this year will be held on Tuesday, Oct. 10 from 1 to 4 p.m. It will feature an afternoon at the Promised Land Zoo in Branson. This attraction features a foot safari, live animal shows, lots of baby animals, parakeet paradise (feed the parakeets) and even bottle-feeding of animals. There will be a nominal fee for this activity—\$3 per preteen and \$10 per person for parents, grandparents, or older brothers or sisters.
