Location of Services: Ridgeline Hotel, 101 S. Saint Vrain Ave., Estes Park, CO 80517. Parking is in front and around behind the hotel. Handicapped driver drop-off and parking is at a pull-through on Saint Vrain, just past the entry to the main parking lot. Special services people will be there to assist you. The first service is at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 4, in the ballroom.

Some of the following activities require advance sign-up and/or payment. Please fill out the form below, make checks payable to COGWA FR and postmark by Aug. 14. Also, please note: although we've seldom had to cancel due to storms, outdoor activities are weather-dependent.

Teen Bowling: For those aged 12-19, Friday, Oct. 6, 1-4 p.m., at Chipper's Lanes, 555 S. Saint Vrain (several blocks south of Ridgeline Hotel). Bowling, shoes and pizza are included in the \$15 per person charge. (Drinks will be available for purchase at the snack bar.) *Pay in advance*.

Family Day: Monday, Oct. 9, at Lake Estes Marina, 1770 Big Thompson Avenue (Highway 34). Dinner will be served at the pavilion at 5 p.m. Parking is close by. We will be grilling burgers and providing side dishes, dessert and drinks. Cost for the meal is \$10 for those aged 12 through adult; \$5 for those aged 5-11; and free for those under 5. *Pay in advance*.

Pontoon boat rides of 20 to 30 minutes around Lake Estes will be available for \$4 per person. These will be between 3 and 5 p.m. (We will establish individual times at Feast site.) **Pay in advance.** Check with the marina for individual boat rentals.

Just across Highway 34 is *Elkins Distillery*. They offer tasting, cocktails and soft drinks for children. They will give us a *free* tour at 4 p.m. Additional times may be available depending on demand. If you are interested in this, we need for you to state on the registration form how many will be coming, so they can be prepared. *No charge, but please indicate how many will be taking the tour*.

Horseback riding will be available right across the street at Sombrero Ranches. A one-hour ride is \$48. Two time slots are available: 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. *Pay in advance*.

Other activities such as bike rentals, volleyball, horseshoes and fishing are available on an individual basis. Fishing licenses, bait and tackle may be purchased/rented in the store. There is even an ADA fishing pier for the handicapped.
