### **Friday, Sept. 25, 7:30-9 p.m.: Opening Night Services (Salons DEF)**

This is a great way to begin our festival worship and fellowship. We'll be in Salons DEF.

### **Saturday, Sept. 26, 1-1:45 p.m.: Festival Youth Instruction (Eisenhower & Lincoln Rooms)**

Classes will be held in the Eisenhower (grades K-2) and Lincoln (grades 3-5) meeting rooms. Parents, please drop off your children 15 minutes early and pick them up immediately after the class (before the start of church services).
