Kohala Coast, Hawaii 2024 Feast Activities

We are pleased to offer several planned activities for families and individuals at the Feast in Hawaii this year! The schedule of activities is listed below. Of course, you may sign up for one or more of these activities. Some are free of charge, and others require prepayment. We need to know how many plan to attend each of our events, so we may prepare for activities. Numbers of attendees are limited for some of the paid events, so please order your tickets early. *The deadline for ordering tickets is Sept. 15!*

We are also planning to provide a Hawaiian name tag for each person attending the Feast in Hawaii this year. Make sure you stop by the Information Table and pick up your name tag and activity tickets.

Discounts: All those staying at the Hilton Waikoloa Village Resort will enjoy the following concessions and discounts:

- Daily resort fee waived (\$45 value).
- Lagoon and beach toys at 20% discount.
- Free Internet access and PlayStation 3 access.
- Complimentary 15-minute photo session and souvenir keepsake.
- Children aged 4 and under free; children aged 5-12 receive 50% discount at catered meals.

Parking and Use of Hotel Amenities: For our attendees, we have negotiated self-parking at \$20 per night for Hilton Waikoloa Village Resort guests during your stay at the hotel (regular rate is \$48 per night). This charge will be added to your room account. Resort amenities (like beach/pool towels and use of the swimming pools) are only for hotel guests.

If you stay off-property, we have parking passes for the self-parking lot. Daily parking passes are \$20/day for our attendees (normally \$48). If you would like parking passes, please request one on the ticket order form and let us know how many days you need parking passes when ordering. You may plan to pick parking passes up at the Information Table at the Welcome Reception and Sunset Dinner, or at the Information Table. Please note: Overnight parking at the hotel is only allowed for registered hotel guests.

Activity Descriptions

Welcome Reception and Sunset Dinner: Wednesday, Oct. 16, 5:30-7:30 p.m.

All attendees are invited to a get-acquainted plated dinner to meet and greet old and new friends at the Hilton's Lagoon Lanai. A Hawaiian sunset dinner will be served, and a cash bar will be available for those who reserve a spot and order a ticket. Prepaid price includes tax and gratuity. *Prepayment is required for this event.*

Again, tickets must be purchased ahead of time.

Catered Holy Day Luncheons: Thursday, Oct. 17, and Thursday, Oct. 24, 12-2 p.m.

Private catered luncheons will be offered for our group between services on both holy days (Thursdays this year). This will give everyone additional time for fellowship without waiting for a table and service in a restaurant or getting everyone into a vehicle to travel off-property for lunch. The Hilton Waikoloa Village chef has put together a plated luncheon menu that includes salad, a main entrée of your choice, dessert and beverages in a private setting overlooking the Hilton's private Lagoon. Prepaid price includes all taxes and gratuity. *Prepayment is required for this event*.

Again, tickets must be purchased ahead of time.

Teen Pizza and Pool Party: Friday, Oct. 18, 12:30-4 p.m.

All teens are invited to gather at the Hilton's Ocean Tower pool for a fun-filled afternoon of pizza, activities and swimming. Games and activities will be organized for the teens. Pizza lunch and beverages will be provided to all who sign up ahead of time. There is *no charge* for this activity. However, we would like *all teens to sign up* so we will know how many to expect.

Young Adult Dolphin Quest Encounter: Friday, Oct. 18, 1:30-2:45 p.m.

Young adults are invited to a private group instructional encounter with dolphins at the Dolphin Quest Hawaii desk at the Hilton Hotel's salt water lagoon. Following a 30-minute orientation and instructional class on Pacific dolphins, you will spend approximately 15-20 minutes with an up-close dolphin encounter in the lagoon. Prepaid price includes orientation class, use of safety vest, close-up in-water dolphin encounter and instructor/trainer tip. Sign up early to guarantee your reservation. Participation is limited to 25 people. *Prepayment is required for this activity*.

Again, tickets must be purchased ahead of time.

Family Sail and Snorkel on the *Spirit of Aloha* **Catamaran:** Sunday, Oct. 20, and Monday, Oct. 21, 1-5 p.m.

Enjoy a 3-hour trip aboard the private chartered *Spirit of Aloha* Catamaran (1 p.m. check-in required) with 2-hours of snorkel time. All snorkel equipment is provided. Price includes a box

lunch, beverages and two bar drinks (for adults). Because the catamaran is limited to 48 passengers, we have reserved two chartered sailings (Sunday and Monday). If you want to sail together with others, please make sure you select the same day when ordering tickets. *Prepayment is required for this event.*

Adults (aged 18 and up) \$120 Children (aged 17 and under) \$60

Again, tickets must be purchased ahead of time.

Golf Tournament: Tuesday, Oct. 22, 1-6 p.m.

All golfers (and duffers too) are invited to a best-ball scramble team golf tournament on the Beach Nine and Lakes Nine Courses at the Hilton Waikoloa Village Resort. Its website describes the courses:

"The Beach Nine is a must-play, featuring generous landing areas from the tee boxes and large greens surrounded by low-lipped bunkers to reward the social golfer. Skilled and avid players can be aggressive and be rewarded with multiple birdie opportunities. Hole #6 is the highlight of this loop, a par-five that plays on an emerald ribbon of fairway between black lava fields down to the ocean, then takes a hard dogleg-left to a putting surfaced ringed by swaying palm trees and backed by Pacific waves, creating one of the most beautiful and memorable holes in Hawaii."

"The <u>Lakes Nine</u> winds its way through the heart of the resort, taking its name from the bodies of water that come into play on five of the nine holes. This classic resort-style layout, part of the original Beach Course built back in 1980, will not beat you up with length, but does require strategic shots to avoid lava and water trouble. The lava beds in this area of the resort created some natural elevation changes that were neatly incorporated into the design. Hole #8 is a fun and scenic par-three hole with a water carry to reach the receptive green and a towering wall of lava as a backdrop."

Join us for a delightful afternoon of golf, fun and fellowship! Tickets for this event are \$100 per person. Price includes green fees, taxes, golf cart rental, bottled water and unlimited use of practice facility. Golf club rentals are additional \$40 at the clubhouse on day of event. *Prepayment is required for this activity*
