# Kohala Coast, Hawaii 2025 Feast Activities

We are pleased to offer a variety of planned activities for families and individuals attending the Feast in Hawaii this year! The schedule of activities is listed below. You are welcome to sign up for one or more of these events. Some are free of charge, while others require prepayment.

#### **Discounts:**

Guests staying at the Hilton Waikoloa Village Resort will enjoy the following concessions and discounts:

### Parking and Use of Hotel Amenities:

For our attendees, we have negotiated a self-parking rate of \$20 per night for Hilton Waikoloa Village Resort guests (regular rate is \$48). This charge will be added to your room account. Please note that resort amenities (such as beach and pool towels, and use of the swimming pools) are available only to registered hotel guests.

If you choose to stay off-property, we have arranged for parking passes for the Hilton selfparking lot. Parking passes are \$20 per use for our attendees (normally \$48). Each parking pass is a one-time daily use with no in/out privileges. If you would like parking passes, please request them on the <u>Hawaii - Sign Up for Paid Events</u> and indicate how many days you will need them. You can pick up your parking passes at the Information/Ticket Table during the Welcome Reception and Sunset Dinner or at the Information Table during the Feast. **Please note:** Overnight parking at the hotel is only allowed for registered hotel guests.

# Family Sail and Snorkel on the *Hoku Nui* Catamaran Thursday, Oct. 9 | 2-5 p.m.

Set sail down the historic Kona coastline aboard the *Hoku Nui*, Hawaii's newest 50-foot luxury catamaran. Your sailing and snorkeling adventure will take you to the pristine waters and vibrant reef of Kealakekua Bay, home to the famous Captain Cook Monument.

Enjoy breathtaking views of ancient lava flows, colorful schools of tropical fish and pods of spinner dolphins, which are often spotted in the bay. The tour includes tropical fruits, chips, juices, soft drinks and snacks. Alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase. The excursion lasts approximately three hours, with about one hour dedicated to snorkeling. All snorkel gear—including masks, fins, snorkels and flotation—is provided.

Because the catamaran is limited to 48 passengers, we recommend you book your reservation early. Prepayment is required for this event.

All golfers—seasoned players and casual duffers alike—are invited to join a best-ball scramble team golf tournament on The Beach Nine and Lakes Nine Courses at the Hilton Waikoloa Village Resort.

### The resort's website describes the courses:

"The Beach Nine is a must-play, featuring generous landing areas from the tee boxes and large greens surrounded by low-lipped bunkers to reward the social golfer. Skilled and avid players

can be aggressive and be rewarded with multiple birdie opportunities. Hole #6 is the highlight of this loop, a par-five that plays on an emerald ribbon of fairway between black lava fields down to the ocean, then takes a hard dogleg-left to a putting surface ringed by swaying palm trees and backed by Pacific waves—creating one of the most beautiful and memorable holes in Hawaii."

"The Lakes Nine winds its way through the heart of the resort, taking its name from the bodies of water that come into play on five of the nine holes. This classic resort-style layout, part of the original Beach Course built back in 1980, will not beat you up with length, but does require strategic shots to avoid lava and water trouble. The lava beds in this area of the resort created some natural elevation changes that were neatly incorporated into the design. Hole #8 is a fun and scenic par-three hole with a water carry to reach the receptive green and a towering wall of lava as a backdrop."
