## Kohala Coast, Hawaii 2017 Feast Activities

We are pleased to offer several planned activities for families and individuals at the Feast in Hawaii this year! The schedule of activities is listed below. Of course, you may sign up for one or more of these activities. Some are free of charge, and some require prepayment. We need to know how many plan to attend each of our events, so we may prepare for activities. Numbers of attendees are limited for some of the paid events. So please order your tickets early. *The deadline for ordering tickets is Aug. 28!* To download the order form and order tickets, please go to <u>feast.cogwa.org/sites/hawaii</u>, complete the order form, write a check (made out to Church of God Sacramento) for the total and mail in your check and order form to the address given.

We are also planning to provide a Hawaiian name tag for each person attending the Feast in Hawaii this year. Make sure you stop by Registration/Tickets at the Information Table and pick up your name tag and activity tickets. Again, the *deadline for ordering activity tickets is Aug.* 28!

**Discounts:** At the Fairmont Orchid Hotel, each child (aged 6-12) receives 50 percent off menu pricing at restaurants in the hotel during your stay. Children 5 and under eat free with parents. Our group also will receive a 10 percent discount at all of the hotel's restaurants. To claim your discount, simply show your room key and name tag and mention the discount to the server **before ordering.** This discount does not apply to any of the catered meals or activities, including the sunset buffet dinner and the holy day buffet luncheons.

**Parking and Use of Hotel Amenities:** Please note that self-parking is free for Fairmont Orchid Hotel guests throughout your stay at the hotel. Hotel amenities (like snorkeling equipment, paddleboards, beach/pool towels and use of the swimming pools) are only for hotel guests.
