

## **Kohala Coast, Hawaii 2021 Feast Activities**

We are pleased to offer several planned activities for families and individuals at the Feast in Hawaii this year! The schedule of activities is listed below. Of course, you may sign up for one or more of these activities. Some are free of charge, and some require prepayment. We need to know how many plan to attend each of our events, so we may prepare for activities. Numbers of attendees are limited for some of the paid events, so please **order your tickets early. We are also planning to provide a Hawaiian name tag for each person attending the Feast in Hawaii this year. Make sure you stop by the Information Table and pick up your name tag and activity tickets.

**Discounts:** At the Fairmont Orchid Hotel, each child (aged 6-12) receives 50% off menu pricing at restaurants in the hotel during your stay (excludes In Room Dining, Brown’s Deli and Beach and Pool Grill). Children aged 5 and under eat free (children’s menu) with paying parents.

**Parking and Use of Hotel Amenities:** Please note that self-parking is free for Fairmont Orchid Hotel guests throughout your stay at the hotel. Hotel amenities (like snorkeling equipment, paddleboards, beach/pool towels and use of the swimming pools) are only for hotel guests. If you stay off-property, you may self-park free of charge while attending church services and planned activities. Overnight parking at the hotel is only allowed for registered hotel guests.

**Sunset Buffet Dinner and Welcome Reception:** Monday, Sept. 20, 5:30-7:30 p.m.

All attendees are invited to a get-acquainted sunset buffet dinner to meet and greet old and new friends in the Coconut Grove on the bay at the Fairmont Orchid Hotel. A Hawaiian sunset buffet dinner will be served, and a cash bar will be available for those reserving a spot and ordering a ticket. **Catered Holy Day Buffet Luncheons:** Tuesday, Sept. 21, and Tuesday, Sept. 28, 12-2 p.m.

Private catered luncheons will be offered for our group between services on both holy days. This will give everyone additional time for fellowship without waiting for a table and service in a restaurant or getting everyone into a vehicle to travel off-property for lunch. The Fairmont Orchid Hotel chef has put together a buffet luncheon menu that includes salads, two main

All teens are invited to gather at the Fairmont Orchid Hotel pool area for a fun-filled afternoon of poolside activities and swimming. Games and activities will be organized for the teens. Pizza lunch and beverages will be provided to all who sign up ahead of time. There is ***no charge*** for this activity. **Golf Tournament:** Thursday, Sept. 23, 1-6 p.m.

All golfers (and duffers too) are invited to a best-ball scramble team golf tournament on the Mauna Lani Golf Course. The website describes the North Course:

“Mauna Lani’s North Course represents the quintessential golf experience on the Big Island of Hawaii. Built on a lava bed, the North is characterized by rolling terrain punctuated by Kiawe (mesquite) forests. Number 17, a par three tucked into a natural lava amphitheater, is one of Mauna Lani Resort’s signature holes and a favorite ‘I was here’ photo spot.”

Join us for a delightful afternoon of golf, fun and fellowship! Tickets for this event are \$125 per person. Golf club rentals are additional \$65 at the clubhouse on the day of the event. ***Tickets must be purchased ahead of time. See the [Ticket Order Form](#).***

**Family Sail and Snorkel on the *Body Glove Yacht*:** Friday, Sept. 24, 1-3:30 p.m., and Sunday, Sept. 26, 1-3:30 p.m. (Two sailings on the same chartered yacht.)

Enjoy a 2.5-hour trip aboard the private chartered Body Glove Yacht (12:30 p.m. check-in required) with 1.5 hours of snorkel time. All snorkel equipment is provided. A box lunch with a beverage is included in the price, so no need to stop for lunch on the way to the harbor. Cash bar available on return trip to Kona.
