Wednesday, Oct. 16, 7:30-9 p.m.—Opening Night Service:

Opening services, and all subsequent services, will be held in the Panoramic Room of the AX Hotel's Conference Center. The address is: 860 Rue Lalonde, Mont-Tremblant, QC J8E 1A1. The building is detached from the hotel. The opening service, in French, will begin at 7:30 p.m. (Remember your FM radio with headphones for listening to the translation.)

Friday, Oct. 18, 10 a.m.-12 p.m.—Festival Youth Instruction (grades K-2 only):

Festival Youth Instruction classes for grades K-2 will be held on the 2nd floor of the Conference Center. Parents, please sign the check-in sheet, drop-off your children 15 minutes early and pick them up immediately after church services.

Friday, Oct. 18, 2-4 p.m.—Panoramic Gondola Ride to the top of Mont-Tremblant:

Please note the gondola will shut down for the season on October 20th. Panoramic views make this gondola ride to the top of the mountain one of the most popular activities to enjoy at [Mont-Tremblant](#). Once at the summit, hiking and interpretive nature trails are available as well as the 360° Observation Tower. We will gather at the gondola station at 2 p.m. Participants will need to purchase their own tickets on-site or in advance online.

[Parc Omega](#) is a unique family experience that you will never forget! Passing through the park gates, you will drive your own vehicle on dirt roads through the park to discover a wide variety of animals. Elk, deer and bison roam the park, and they are not afraid of vehicles. Bring a bag of whole carrots to feed them from your vehicle, or purchase carrots at the park.

Other animals such as bears, wolves and Arctic foxes are in very large enclosures carefully designed to resemble their natural environment. The park features a farm with animals for petting, indigenous history and more. We recommend participants check pricing and reserve their tickets in advance online.
