There are, however, three activities and a Bible study we are offering this Feast:

Throughout the Feast: Scavenger Hunt

It will take place through the GooseChase app, available as a free download from both the App Store and Google Play. To participate you will need to form a team of four. The hunt is capped at 200 participants, so don't wait to sign up. Included in your team of four must be one teen (aged 16 and older) or young adult, one or more aged 40 and older and one who is not a physical family member.

Throughout the Feast you will complete tasks listed in the app to earn points. The team with the most points wins. Should there be a tie, the team that finishes first wins. The hunt begins on Saturday night, Oct. 3 at 7 p.m. and ends on Thursday evening, Oct. 8 at 7 p.m. Participants must be aged 16 and older to play as an official member, have a smartphone and have access to transportation to complete tasks.

Sunday, Oct. 4, 2 p.m.: Teen Activity at Mount Atlanticus Miniature Golf Course
