

New Braunfels, Texas 2021 Feast Activities

We are looking forward to having you at the New Braunfels Festival site, a location where there is much to see and do! Here are the activities planned for the Feast of Tabernacles in New Braunfels:

- Teen Activity.
- Golf Tournament.
- Family Day.

Descriptions of Festival Activities:

1. Teen Activity (Wednesday, Sept. 22): This year our teen activity will take place at [Natural Bridge Caverns](#), 26495 Natural Bridge Caverns Rd, San Antonio, TX 78266.

From the website: “Explore Natural Bridge Caverns, Texas’ largest and one of the world’s premier show caves. Take a guided tour through huge underground chambers. Find your way through one of the only permanent outdoor mazes in Texas. Pan for treasure, like miners panned for gold. Or, test your balance, agility and strength against our ropes course and zip rails. It’s Naturally Amazing.”

Each activity is priced separately. You can go online and pre-purchase tickets at a discount or pay at the park. For the two cavern tours, tours leave every 40 minutes, each taking approximately 60 to 70 minutes to complete.

We welcome teens and their families for this activity. If parents would like to arrange for a chaperone for their teen, please contact the activity coordinator, Andy Burnett, at 501-213-7575. Families of teens may decide to go on their own or meet up at the front entrance at 1 p.m. so they can participate in the activities in groups.

We’ll hold a brief meeting after services on Tuesday, Sept. 21, the first day of the Feast of Tabernacles, to finalize plans for Wednesday’s activity.

2. Golf Tournament (Thursday, Sept. 23): We are planning a four-person scramble golf outing during the Feast on Thursday, Sept. 23, at [The Bandit Golf Club](#). The cost will be \$40 per person. You can form your own team, or we can place you with other golfers.

If you would like to play, please send an email to Greg Swartz (gtsjas@gmail.com) letting him know of your desire to play and whether you have a team or wish to be placed on a team. We will plan on a meeting at the Feast site, probably on Wednesday, to confirm final details.

3. Family Day Activity (Friday, Sept. 24): This year our Family Day offers you, your family and your friends an opportunity to enjoy an African Safari, Texas style. The location will be at [Natural Bridge Wildlife Ranch](#), 26515 Natural Bridge Caverns Rd, San Antonio, TX 78266.

From the website: “Ostrich feathers, Zebra ears, and Buffalo noses so close you could touch them! That’s Natural Bridge Wildlife Ranch—one of Texas’ most recognized family entertainment attractions. Meander through 450 acres of rolling hills, creek beds, and magnificent live oak trees. Witness the behavior of over 500 animals from more than 40 different exotic, native and endangered animal species from across the globe. Grab your Safari hat, and join us for the adventure of a lifetime—your very own African Safari, Texas Style!”

As a safety precaution, outside animals, pets or service animals are not permitted at the park. Plan to arrive anytime that day after services conclude. Travel time from the Feast site to the park entrance is approximately 35 minutes. The entrance closes at 5 p.m., and the exit closes at 6:30 p.m.

Admission fees (pay at the entrance; tax not included): \$16.99 for children aged 3-11, \$24.99 for adults aged 12-64, \$22.99 for seniors aged 65 and older.
