We are looking forward to having you at the New Braunfels Festival site, a location where there is much to see and do! Here are the activities planned for the Feast of Tabernacles in New Braunfels:

- Teen Activity.
- Ordained and Department Head Reception.
- Golf Tournament.

- Seniors' Luncheon.

Descriptions of Festival Activities

1. Teen Activity (Wednesday, Oct. 8): All teens are invited to an afternoon of bowling between 2-4 p.m. at Fiesta Bowling Lanes, 1202 Huisache Ave., New Braunfels, TX 78130. The cost for rental shoes and bowling will be \$15 per person.

2. Ordained and Department Head Reception (Wednesday, Oct. 8): All of our ordained members serving in COGWA and those serving as department heads at the Feast are invited to a reception at the Swartz/Slaughter AirBnB in Gruene about 10 minutes from the convention center (specific location details will be provided). This is a drop-in activity to be held from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Tex-Mex food and assorted drinks will be served. Come and meet your fellow laborers here in New Braunfels. Your immediate family is also welcome.

3. Golf Tournament (Thursday, Oct. 9): This year's golf tournament will be held at Landa Park Golf Course (180 Golf Course Road, New Braunfels, TX 78130). We have five tee times reserved starting at 1 p.m. The cost is \$50 per person and everyone will need to bring their own golf clubs (there are only four sets available to rent).

4. Family and Youth Day (Friday, Oct. 10): This year's special activity for youth and families will feature things special to the city of New Braunfels. This event will begin with a catered meal of German food (to match the heritage of the city) in the Ballroom beginning at 12:15 p.m., followed by a short lecture at 1:15 p.m. on the history of New Braunfels by a resident tour guide, and then the opportunity for everyone to visit historic sites in the city.

Recommended donations for the meal are \$12 for adults (aged 12 and up), \$6 for children (aged 5-11) and free for children (aged 4 and under). If you cannot afford the meal, come anyway. We want everyone to have the opportunity to enjoy a meal together and hear about the city of New Braunfels. Donations may be turned in at the serving line the day of the event or on any day at the Information Table.

5. Bible Study (Friday, Oct. 10): On Friday evening everyone is invited to attend a special study, which will begin at 7:30 p.m. in the main auditorium.

6. Seniors' Luncheon (Sunday, Oct. 12): A special luncheon is being planned for our much-appreciated senior citizens, aged 65 and over, and their spouses. Please come to the Ballroom, adjacent to the auditorium, by 12:15 p.m.
