Local Activity Venue Discounts

In the month of October children aged 11 and younger are admitted free to both the San Diego Zoo and the San Diego Zoo Safari Park. However, the tours that come with the usual paid admission (such as the guided bus tour and Skyfari aerial tram) are not included. These experiences will range between \$4 and \$10 per child. Other tours are offered that are in addition to admission, and these will be regular price for all. Groups of 15 to 99 people can get a 10 percent discount off of admission. Regular admission (not counting Kids Free October) is \$50 for those aged 12 and up, \$40 for those aged 3-11, and always free for those 2 and younger. There is also a AAA discount of 10 percent off of admission for up to six people per card.

Tickets for Sea World or the San Diego Zoo can be purchased at a discount from the front desk of the Crowne Plaza. As an added benefit, they will also shuttle you to the venue, saving you as much as \$17 in parking fees and enabling you not to have to wait in line to enter.
