

San Diego, California 2019 Feast Activities

Local Activity Venue Discounts

In the month of October, children aged 11 and younger are admitted [free](#) to both the San Diego Zoo and the San Diego Zoo Safari Park. However, the tours (such as the guided bus tour and Skyfari aerial tram) are not included. These experiences range between \$4 and \$10 per child. Other tours are offered at their regular price for all in addition to admission. Groups of 15 to 99 people can get a 10% discount off of admission.

Regular admission (not counting Kids Free October) is around \$56 for those aged 12 and up, \$40 for those aged 3-11, and always free for those aged 2 and younger. There is also an AAA discount of 10% off of admission for up to six people per card.

Complimentary shuttle service from the Handlery is offered to the San Diego Zoo, Balboa Park, SeaWorld, Fashion Valley Mall and Old Town. Shuttle service is also offered for businesses, attractions and restaurants within a five-mile radius of the hotel, based on availability. Complimentary shuttle service does not go to or from the airport and has limited hours. Please check with the hotel for current hours of operation.

Teen Beach Party—Tuesday, Oct. 15, 1-5 p.m.

On Tuesday, Oct. 15, there will be a teen beach party on Coronado Island at *Central Beach*. Take Hwy 75 into Coronado (which becomes Orange Ave.) and take a right on Isabella Ave. out to Ocean Blvd. Look for the Central Beach bathroom and Volleyball Courts. The beach party is from 1 to 5 p.m. Supervision will be provided. Pizza, drinks and snacks will be served free of charge for all teens. Come join teens from around the U.S. for volleyball, football, Frisbee, swimming and boogie boarding.

A special dinner cruise has been set up for anyone who would like to join on Wednesday, Oct. 16, from 6:30-10 p.m. San Diego has much to offer in the day, but it is also a beautiful place at night, especially the San Diego Harbor at sunset!
