

Tucson, Arizona 2021 Feast Activities

Tucson has much to offer in the way of activities. Mount Lemmon offers wonderful scenic driving, hiking or rock climbing, the Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum, the Pima Air & Space Museum, the International Wildlife Museum, Saguaro National Park, Sabino Canyon Recreation Area, Catalina State Park, the “church history” famous Pinnacle Peak Steakhouse and saloon, and to the south of Tucson, Tombstone, Arizona.

Try a Jeep or Hummer desert tour, or simply take a hike right out of the resort. Guided hikes are provided for resort guests through Loews Ventana, early every morning. Any members can choose to take a short walk through the resort to a beautiful waterfall that feeds the resort ponds. The resort also has a large pool, tennis courts, a spa and golf courses. There is literally something for everyone.

Holy Day Buffet Lunch—Tuesday, Sept. 21, 12-1:30 p.m.

On the first holy day the Loews Ventana will provide a buffet lunch served by the Loews resort staff on the patio just steps outside the Kiva Ballroom. Tables with umbrellas will provide a nicely shaded area for lunch without having to leave the resort. This was a success last year, and very well received.

The buffet is **\$52 per adult, \$35 per child aged 4 to 12 and free for children aged 3 and under if purchased in advance**. During the Feast, the hotel may charge a higher rate. Other options for lunch include three restaurants on site with *limited seating*, or going off site for lunch.

Payment for meals is nonrefundable as we are required to prepay in advance of the Feast.
