The wildlife around Victoria is spectacular, diverse, enchanting and memorable. The possibilities are endless:

- Gray whales
- Humpback whales
- Minke whales
- Fin whales (rare)
- Dall's porpoise
- Harbor porpoise
- Seals
- Sea lions
- Eagles

And there are numerous sea and shore birds for the ornithologists, and sea stars, giant kelp and other intertidal delights for everyone.
