Red Wing's Pottery and Shoe Museums—Thursday, Oct. 13.

Explore Red Wing, Minnesota, located on the banks of the beautiful Mississippi. Highway 61 along the Mississippi is one of Minnesota's great scenic roads. Red Wing is only 45 minutes

from Woodbury. Red Wing is famous for Red Wing Pottery and Red Wing Shoes. The museums for each are quite interesting. Allow an hour for each location.

Pottery Museum of Red Wing:

240 Harrison St, Red Wing, MN. Huge collection, incredible workmanship, artistry. Admission is free. Closes at 5 p.m.

Red Wing Shoe Store and Museum:

315 Main St, Red Wing, MN. (Parking behind the store at Plum and Third.) Get your picture with the world's largest boot. Museum is on second floor (elevator available) over a working store.

Ask about the Ultimate Fit Experience to get your feet measured electronically, at no charge. There is an olive oil and vinegar store near the Red Wing Shoe Store, if you are interested.

We recommend driving back during daylight to avoid a possible encounter with a deer, and enjoy the river views.

National Eagle Center—Thursday, Oct. 13.

Wabasha is 72 miles from Woodbury, a gorgeous drive on Hwy 61 along the Mississippi River. With light traffic it will take one hour and 20 minutes for the drive. Minnesota has more eagles than any state besides Alaska. There is a 3 p.m. show with a live eagle and naturalist (\$15 per person). The show requires walking up some stairs. Not recommended if you have mobility issues.

Also see live eagles in the main building before the show where a naturalist answers questions. Interesting exhibits on second floor. We recommend seeing all the exhibits before the 3 p.m. show. Then head back to Woodbury before dark to avoid an encounter with a deer.

Wabasha is the site of the "Grumpy Old Men" movie. Slippery's Restaurant is based on Slippery's Bar in the movie and has a lovely location right on the river.
