Kohler-Andrae State Park: Plan to visit beautiful Kohler-Andrae State Park, located just six miles south of Blue Harbor on Highway V. Kohler-Andrae State Park is the home of majestic sand dunes, miles of golden beach, whispering pines, an abundance of wildlife and a variety of nature trails. The two-mile Dunes Cordwalk runs parallel to the Lake Michigan shoreline, and hikers will see active and stabilized sand dunes, interdunal wetlands and a dry-mesic white pine forest in the Kohler Park Dunes State Natural Area. A Wisconsin State Park sticker is required on all motor vehicles within the park and can be purchased at the park entrance. Price is \$7 for a daily sticker, Wisconsin

resident (license plate); \$3 for a Wisconsin resident aged 65 and older; \$10 for a nonresident (out-of-state license plate).
